

PRACTISS Seizure Scenario Supporting Roles

Role	Description (Role, Behaviour, Key Moments, Script)
Bedside RN	<p>Role: You are at the bedside to provide the learner with information about the patient and to assist as needed with tasks.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Stage 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If asked for history: You know that Mr. Wright has lung cancer and is awaiting a lobectomy. His primary issues in hospital have been pain control and his meds have been increased almost daily. <p style="text-align: center;">Stage 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Depending on the mannequin being used and the facilitator's choices, you may also have to cue the learners as to when the patient begins seizing and will need to continuously prompt about the seizures until the second benzodiazepine dose is given.
On-Call Staff	<p>Role: You will arrive during the second stage. Can assist with care and provide guidance on the provision of medication. The resident will also debrief you at the end of the case.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Stage 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive and ask "What's going on?"
