Role	Description (Role, Behaviour, Key Moments, Script)
<b>Mother</b>	<p>You have just brought your daughter to the ER. Like any other parent, you are very concerned for her well-being. You will provide the medical history and a history of the presenting complaint. As the case goes on, You will become more and more agitated and intrusive, unless you are addressed by the learners in the room.</p> <p><b>History:</b> Your daughter has been tired and unwell for 3 days with some mild abdominal pain and vomiting. She recently became confused and lethargic. She doesn't have any major medical history, and there isn't much in the way of family history of illness. Your daughter lives with you, your husband, and her 1 older brother.</p> <p><b>Stage 3 - PEA Arrest</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You become more agitated when your daughter goes into arrest, you will become increasingly agitated if you are not addressed by the learners.</li></ul>
