Role	Description (Role, Behaviour, Key Moments, Script)
Mother	<p>You are the patient's mother and are very concerned for their safety. If learners ask, you will help provide the recent history. You just brought them there after they ate cake at a birthday party, and gave them their epi-pen when their reaction started. You know they're allergic to peanuts, and you think that there must've been traces of peanut in the cake. You're frustrated that this happened, because you're usually really careful about this sort of thing.</p> <p>Stage 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will be at the bedside, and become increasingly agitated and obstructive if not consoled <p>Stage 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before intubating your daughter, the learners will ask for your consent for the procedure, which you will provide <p>Stage 6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When your daughter stabilizes, the learners should update you on her condition and prognosis. If they do not, you will become very upset and question the quality of the care they've provided. You could threaten to sue them or threaten to press charges if they do not de-escalate.
