Role	Description (Role, Behaviour, Key Moments, Script)
Bedside RN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="456 310 1406 457">● You've been looking after Mr. Lewis. He was quite uncomfortable (leg pain) at the start of your shift and required 2 doses of 10mg oral morphine (at 1900 and 2200). On your subsequent vitals you find him somnolent and difficult to rouse.<li data-bbox="456 468 1128 499">● You know that he received a visitor earlier today<li data-bbox="456 510 1089 541">● Wait for the resident to ask for vitals, O2, etc. <p data-bbox="391 583 1341 651">IF the resident doesn't appreciate the low respiratory rate, mention "he's breathing really slowly... I don't think he's breathing".</p>
